Introducing Whiskey and Spirit Lockers.

A unique way to enjoy your personal choice of an exclusive drop, on your own, or with friends. Choose from our variety of stocked and rare bottles, or let us know what you would like to hold in your locker and we will try and source it for you. (Conditions apply)

You can also gift a bottle to someone special in their very own locker.

As a locker member, we'll store your bottles and be sure to have all accompaniments ready on your next visit. Enjoy that truly VIP feeling drinking from your very own locker when hosting friends, family, colleagues or clients. You will also enjoy invites to special and exclusive events.

How does it Work?

To secure a Whiskey Locker, fill in an expression of interest form. Our Bar Manager will reach out to start your bottle selection process. Once your bottle is purchased, your locker is secured. Lockers will be allocated on a 'first in first served' basis. The "Liquor Locker" service fee of \$200 for a 3-month period which includes hire of your locker and complimentary ice, premium glassware, water, and appropriate garnishes each time a pour is provided. An extra charge will be incurred if you request specialty drink mixers.

What do I need to do to keep my locker after my initial bottle purchase?

Whiskey Locker members will be required to purchase another bottle from our list every 3 months to continue to secure your locker. This can be done in the Scarborough Bar when you visit.

The \$200 service fee will be invoiced to you on a 7-day account. Unpaid service fees will result in your locker and its contents being reclaimed by the Scarborough Bar.

You will receive a reminder that your bottle locker is up for renewal 1 week prior to expiry. In the highly unlikely event, you do not wish to renew your locker, you will need to collect any unfinished bottles within 7 days after locker expiry, or any remaining "Bottles" will become the property of The Scarborough Bar.

What do I need to do to drink from my locker?

All locker members will be prioritized wherever possible and reasonable. When arriving, please let staff know you are there to enjoy your locker and they will serve you. All serves will be recorded and you will be asked to sign at the end of your visit to acknowledge what has been served to you.

Other things to know

Spirit lockers cannot be transferred between those that are not on the official locker waitlist and lockers will be allocated in order of application date. In the event that you no longer wish to have a locker, your locker will be released to the next person on the waitlist.

"Bottles" purchased for use in the "Liquor Locker" are only to be consumed at The Scarborough Bar and may not leave the licenced premises at any time unless cancelling your liquor locker.

All "Bottles" will remain inside the numbered "Liquor Locker", with access only by staff members of The Scarborough Bar.

A member can nominate ongoing representatives (such as family, friends, colleague, clients etc.) to visit and consume their "Bottle(s)" at any time with written notification to the Bar Manager (sb@beachhousehotel.com.au) It must state the guests name, approximate time of visit and any stipulations on the consumption amounts of the "Bottles" in the "Liquor Locker". ID must be provided on request to access the locker.

When a "Bottle(s)" is requested to be consumed by a "Liquor Locker" holder (or their authorised delegate) it must be poured and served by a team member of The Scarborough Bar.

All pours will be measured in 30ml nips and recorded to which the member (or their authorised delegate) will be asked to sign and acknowledge the quantity at the conclusion of their visit. Records of consumption will be kept in the venue in a ledger system.

Responsible Service of Alcohol is a priority at all times. Our team have the right to refuse service at any given time.
